Overdue Materials Policy

- 1. The overdue fine for books, books on tape, CDs, magazines, and non-fiction videos and DVDs is 10¢ per item per day. There is a 3-day grace period for most items and a 1-day grace period for new items.
- 2. The overdue fine for fiction videos and DVDs is \$1.00 per item per day. There is no grace period for fiction videos and DVDs.
- 3. An overdue notice will be sent to you when your materials are 10 days overdue. Second and third notices will be sent at 10-day intervals. A final notice, which includes the text of City Ordinance 312.156, is sent when materials are more than a month overdue. Failure to receive notices does not release the borrower from liability.
- 4. Books that are returned in the book drop when the library is closed will be checked in with the previous open day's date.
- 5. The Clare County Sheriff's Department will be utilized to collect unreturned materials.

Harrison City Ordinance 312.156

After a period of 15 days grace beyond past due date, the non-return of any loan items such as books, periodicals, tapes, and other materials shall be declared an unlawful misdemeanor subject to \$100.00 fine and/or 90 days in jail.
